GOLDEN MUNICIPAL CAMPGROUND

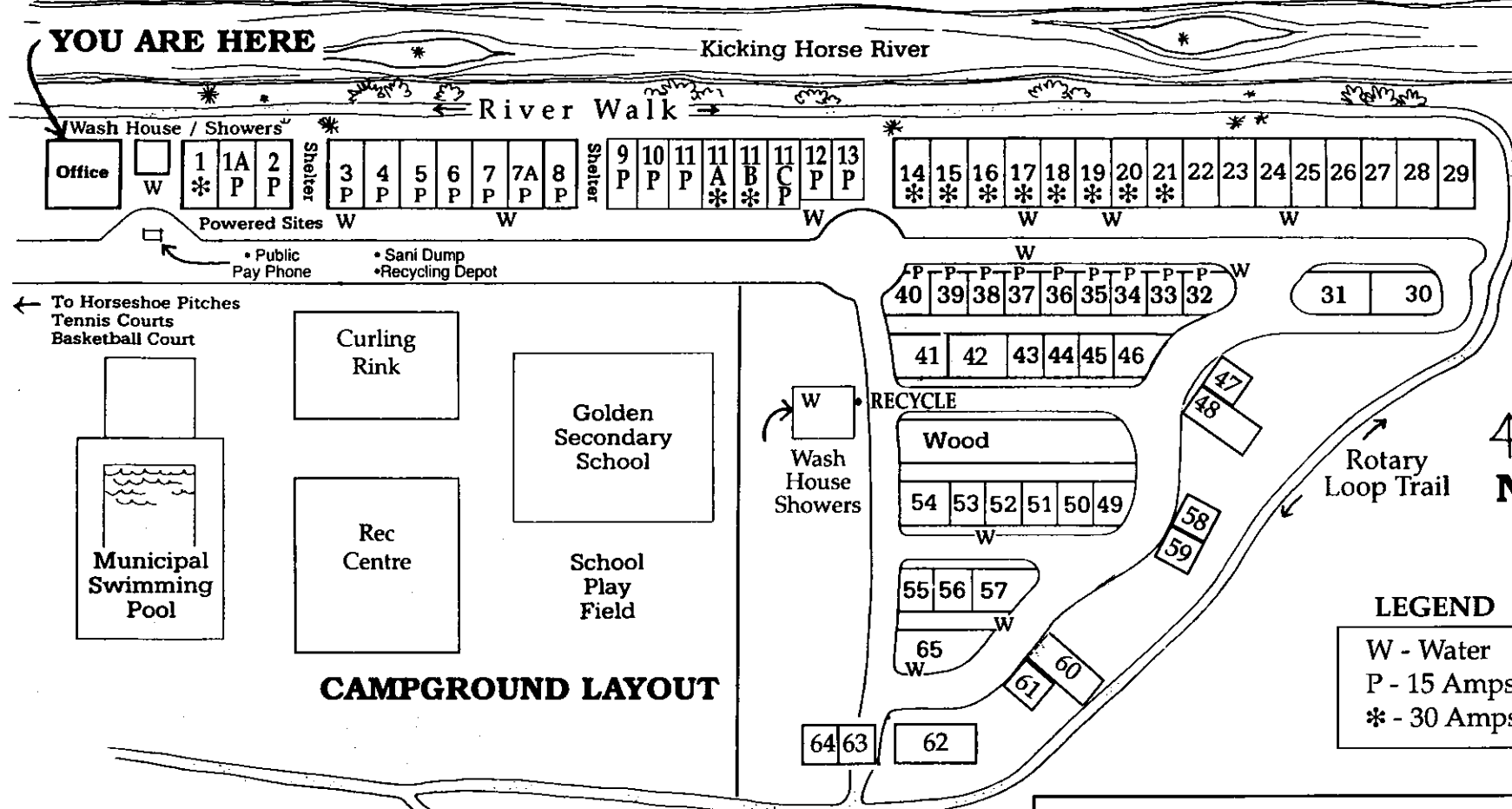
Welcome to the Golden Municipal Campground.

We hope you have a pleasant visit. Following is some information that may be of help to you in enjoying your stay with us.

- Office hours are 5 p.m. to 11 p.m. seven days a week. If you have any questions regarding the campground or the local area, feel free to ask the office or any campground staff member.
- There is bagged cube and block ice available from the campground office. Cost is \$2.50 (includes GST).
- There are coin-operated hot showers available for men and women in both bathrooms. Quarters are available during office hours.
- Firewood is provided by the campground for a small fee. The wood bin is located near the east wash house. Please ensure your fire is under control when you leave your campsite, retire for the night or depart the campground.
- **When you leave your campsite and when you retire for the night please be sure that you place any food, cooler and valuables inside your vehicle / tent/ RV. Unattended coolers (particularly those containing alcoholic beverages) can "walk away" during the night. Don't let it be yours.**
- Try to respect the rights of your fellow campers for a quiet, peaceful night. Excessive noise is not allowed after 11 p.m. and before 7 a.m. If you have any complaints about noise levels, contact the office or any campground staff. After 11 p.m., please call the RCMP at 344-2221.
- Make sure that you have some type of insect repellent available if you plan outside activities. No insect control program is 100% effective.
- There is access to the river at the eastern end of the campground but swimming or bathing are NOT recommended as the river is glacier fed and there are dangerous currents. No supervision is provided.
- Four dumpsters are located on the grounds. We would ask you to leave your site as you found it and deposit all garbage in the dumpsters. There is also a recycling bin for aluminum pop cans next to the sani-dump at the campground entrance.
- If you will be returning for another visit later in the season, remember to reserve a site prior to your departure.
- Try to take advantage of the beautiful walks in the immediate area. There are two that start at the campground - the Rotary Loop Trail and the East Kootenay Environmental Society's Reflection Lake Trail. Trails are marked on the map of the campground.

WALKS FROM CAMPGROUND

Rotary Loop Trail - 4 km. round trip, 50 meter elevation gain. Follow trail signs from southeast portion of campground. Accesses soccer and softball playfields with a 10 minute walk.

River Walk - 5 km. return, no elevation gain. Follow river dike south of campground, across Highway 95 at bridge and continue on dike to confluence of Kicking Horse and Columbia Rivers.

These are a few courtesy rules that will help make your stay with us as pleasant and memorable as possible. Should you have a concern, please contact the office.

Noise Quiet time is 11 pm. All music is to be kept at reasonable levels at all times & turned off by 11 pm. Campers with complaints about noise levels should inform the office and after 11 pm contact the RCMP at 344 2221 or 911 for Emergencies.

Fire Pits Pits are for burning firewood only. Please do not burn garbage or use your fire pit as a garbage can.

Picnic Tables There is a table for each site. If you combine tables, they must be moved back before you leave.

Guests All guests must leave the campground by 11 pm.

Pets Pets are to be on leashes at all times. Please clean up after your pet.

Checkout Checkout time is 11 am. Please vacate your site if you will not be staying another night. Late checkout can be arranged with the office if required.

Speed Limit Speed limit is 15 KMP. Watch for children!!!

Washing Dishes Please wash your dishes in the outside sinks at the wash houses. Do not wash them inside the wash house.
