BYLAW NUMBER 973

Being a Bylaw of the Town of Golden
to amend "Traffic, Parking and Streets Regulations
Bylaw Number 966, 1995."

WHEREAS Council has adopted "Traffic, Parking and Streets
Regulations Bylaw Number 966, 1995;"

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend Bylaw Number 966, 1995;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Golden, in open meeting
assembled,

HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Town of Golden "Traffic, Parking and Streets Regulations
Bylaw Number 966, 1995" is hereby amended as follows:

i) ARTICLE 3 - PARKING REGULATIONS:

x) the words "...or unloaded..." are deleted. Article
3(x) reads:

"no truck, loaded, shall be left parked in any
residential zone within the Town."

ii) ARTICLE 3A - RECREATIONAL VEHICLES AND TRAILERS:

(a), (b), and (c) are deleted in their entirety;

(d) is changed to (a) and reads:

"no operator or owner of a recreational vehicle shall
park the recreational vehicle on any street within the
Town in such a manner as to constitute a hazard to other
persons using the street."

2. This Bylaw may be cited as the Town of Golden "Traffic,
Parking and Streets Regulations (Amendment) Bylaw Number 973,
1996."

3. This Bylaw shall take effect upon its adoption by the Council
of the Town of Golden.

READ A THIRD TIME, this 5th day of February, 1996.
