

# PARKING

## DOWNTOWN GOLDEN

### General

- Make sure accessible spots remain open for those who need them.
- Keep driveways and lanes clear.
- Don't park in such a way that blocks emergency vehicles.
- Don't park in such a way that blocks snow removal.

### Downtown

- The downtown core has a limit of two-hour parking between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m.
- If you work downtown, if possible, please use your businesses parking lot.
- All-day parking is available as outlined below, or cross the Highway 95 Bridge and park in the lot next to Kumsheen Park or on 9<sup>th</sup> Ave S. near Town Hall.
- RVs and trailers can park along 7<sup>th</sup> St. N and in the CP parking lot (no overnight parking!).

### Residential Parking

- Trailers of any kind, when parked, must always be attached to a vehicle.
- Recreation vehicles can't be parked on any street, unless attached to the vehicle used to draw it.
- No truck, loaded/unloaded, or oversized vehicle can be left parked in any residential zone within the Town.
- When it snows, move vehicles off roadways and out of alleyways. Alleyways should be clear of woodpiles, boats, cars and travel trailers.



### Legend

#### Downtown Parking Zones/Time Limits

- 15 minutes
- 2 hours (from 9 a.m. - 6 p.m.)
- All day (no overnight)

1. Post Office
2. Chamber of Commerce/ Information Centre
3. Spirit Square
4. Public Washrooms
5. Kicking Horse Pedestrian Bridge
6. CP Parking Lot
- 7&8. Public Parking lots

### Enforcement

If you do get a ticket for a parking infraction, paying it within 14 days saves you \$20! If not, you risk a surcharge of \$20 after 28 days. If you fail to pay within 28 days, further penalties may apply.
